The High School Education and Prevention program provides students with knowledge of how the brain works and what happens when it is injured. The program is a 2 part presentation targeted to grade 11/12 psychology students.

- Part 1: Introduction
Neuroanatomy
Acquired Brain Injury (Mechanisms of injury)
The Thinking Company – Analogy (Outcomes of injury)
- Part 2: Survivor Stories

With prevention as our central theme, the presentation provides students with information of how most injuries occur and ways to prevent injury. The presentation focuses on the five choices presented through the Heroes Program developed by the Smart Risk Foundation. The five choices - "Buckle Up", "Drive Sober", "Get Trained", "Wear the Gear" and "Look First" demonstrate that we all take risks as a part of life. By making the right choices, we can live to risk again.

Since the programs conception in 1998, we have presented to approximately 5000 high school students.
