Kindergarten

The Kindergarten Education and Prevention program takes place each spring at the local health units. Each child attends the health units for their inoculations. Prior to leaving the building they attend the prevention clinic. BrainTrust Canada is available to educate kindergarten children about injury prevention by way of playing the world-renowned "slimmy-wet-spongy-brain-toss" game. The Kindergarten Program allows the introduction of important safety messages to our impressionable youth. We demonstrate safe behaviour that provides a solid base for learning and reinforces positive safe activities that can become second nature from an early age.

This involves asking each child 5 very important questions: What is your name? Where is your brain? What does your brain do? What do you wear on your head to protect your brain? What activities do you do when you should wear your helmet? These questions allow us an opportunity to let these young impressionable children know that their brain is important and should be protected by using a helmet. After the child gets the correct answers, they have the opportunity to toss 3 "spongy" brains into a bucket. They are awarded with a small prize for the efforts and the parents are informed of the importance of injury prevention.
